A recovery at a good pace

Bron traveled well and Saint-Genis Laval and Asul made their debut

This first game of the season starts loudly. The Bron set aligns a powerful and athletic rear base. The Cantaliennes are looking for solutions with quick ball climbs. The balance is perfect at the 10th minute (7-7). The pressing exercised by the locals then gives some advantages but the visitors soon restore the balance. Upon recovery, they stand guard a little more. Under the leadership of Sophie Boyer, they overflow with the then confused visitors but the game is far from over because Bron's team gradually regains its standing and ends up picking up at the score (28-28, 53 e). The end is difficult for exhausted locals. They find themselves led by 2 goals, but with energy they win the draw.

Saint-Genis Laval 32 Toulon Saint-Cyr 30

In Saint-Genis-Laval, Saint-Genis-Laval beats Toulon/St Cyr 32-30 (15-15). Referees: Mr. Guilloux and Tardy.

Points for Saint-Genis-Laval: Poulet 9, Gafsi 7, Croze 6, Pivot 5, Roux 2, Paturel (Cap) 2 and Brun 1. Exclusion 2: Chicken 18 e, Gafsi 28 e 45 e, Croze 50 e.,

Toulon/Saint-Cyr: Rousseau 10, Aline 7, Begot 5, Rosso 3, Rovira 2, Lecut 2, Begot 1 and Giraudo (Cap). Exclusion 2: Da Silva 15 e, Iglesias 53 e,

Barthelemy 40 e and Rovira 45 e.

Saint-Genis-Laval performs the right operation for its beginnings at home. Quickly Champin's players take the match in hand by Chicken and Pivot at the finish (5-1, 5th). The defenses take precedence over the attacks and Toulon slowly returns to the game (8-5, 15th). Despite a great lack of success at 6 meters, the Saint-Genoises maintain the gap by Gafsi (9-7, 20th). The Varoises return with a quick game at the end of the half-time to return to the break (15-15, 30th). Upon returning from the locker room, Saint-Genis-Laval regained the advantage by Poulet (18-17, 35 e). The game stabilizes between the two teams that are struggling to find solutions in front of the goals (23-20, 45th). The Varoises often reduced in numerical inferiority take a severe 4-0 by Gafsi and Pivot (27-21, 50 e). Locals master the meeting without difficulty (30-26, 60 e). This is without counting on Toulon, which sets up a strict double that brings them back to the score (30-29, 58 e). The chicken and croze profession does the rest to offer a deserved first victory to the promoted.

At the Palais des Sports (Vaulx-en-Velin), ASUL beat Port-de-Bouc on the score of 44-21 (half-time: 22-11).

The Aslist reserve made its debut. Reinforced by the descents of Maëlle Grenouillat, Pauline Lambert (returning from injury) and Mylène Giacomin, the difference in level, on a physical and technical terms, is felt from the first minutes of the confrontation. Led by a creative and effective Mylène Giacomin, the Vaudaises take the lead on the scoreboard.

In the 18th minute, a moment chosen by Port-de-Bouc to ask for a dead time, they lead 14-7. Doubts about the identity of the winner of the day are lifted. So, playing time is given to the start-ups, like Diana Rasovic, who goes from her small goal on counterattack. At half-time, with 12 stops by Maëlle Grenouillat, ASUL returns to the locker room with 11 units in advance: 22-11.

Similarly, the second half is only a formality, Laure Lagache, alone, shaking the opposing nets nine times. A first full of promises.
